

Toronto Cup 2023 Invitation Letter

November 4-5, 2023

Location: Great Toronto Area (more details soon)



Dates

The second edition of the Toronto Cup competition will start **Saturday, November 4th** at **9am** and will finish **Sunday November 5th** no later than **5pm**.

Two competitions will be held at the same time. One for the women teams and one for the men teams.

Location

The competition will take place in the GTA (Great Toronto Area), more likely at **Balmoral Drive Senior Public School** in Brampton **but final location will be provided later on**. It is located at around 1h drive from Toronto Downtown and around 20 minutes from Toronto Pearson Airport. The full address is:

Competition format

The maximum number of teams will be limited to 8 (women and men teams combined). Each game will be played on a 35m by 20m Handball court with official goals.

On **Saturday**, teams will face each other in **Round Robin format** as a group stage.

On Sunday, Playoff and placement games will take place.

The **winning team** will receive one **trophy** and **medals** for each players.

Competition format may change depending on the number of registered teams. Each game will be a minimum **two half of 20 minutes** and **4 games per team** will be guaranteed.

Equipment restrictions

NO RESIN OR STICKHUM IS ALLOWED DURING THE COMPETITION. We will provide brand new balls that have been designed to be used without stickum (Decatlhon Attorka waxfree)



All shoes used in the gymnasium must be non-marking shoes.

Breaking the above rules will result in disqualification and the collect of the sportsmanship bond.

Team requirements

Any team of adult players (16+) can register for the competition. Each team has to register a minimum of 10 players (including at least one goalkeeper) and 16 players maximum. The full roster of each team has to be registered no later than one week before the beginning of the competition.

Participation fees

- 1. The participation fee is **CAD\$600 per team**.
- 2. Each team has to pay a **minimum roster bond** of **CAD\$250**. This amount will be held in escrow and returned to the team at the end of the competition if the "Team requirements" (see above) have been respected.
- 3. Each team has to pay a **sportsmanship bond** of **CAD\$250**. This amount will be held in escrow and returned to the team at the end of the competition if the IHF Fair play Rules have been respected.

The total fees of **CAD\$1100** has to be paid no later than **Sunday October 22nd**, **2023**. Cheques can be brought during the event also to avoid money transfer.
